The treasurer's report and the minutes were both accepted as read.

We decided against Lyle's proposals. We cannot afford the memorial plazas he suggested, and the ghost building were deemed too expensive, and both intrusive and dangerous. We need to find out more about Benjamin Rumsey before we go ahead with any sort of commertation, especially as there are strong feelings about slavery.
