

Vestry Meeting December 11, 2018

In attendance: Fr. B., Betty Bennet, Beverly Logan, Ron Meyer, Colleen Rhine, Dani Rice

The meeting was opened at 6:15 with a prayer by Fr. B.

Pastoral Report: Charles Ames is still the hospital at North-Arundel and is in “bad shape”. Both Fr. B and Ron Meyer have visited him. Fr. B has spoken to Janis Johnson and the Millers. Anita Britt is “problematical”, as the daughter has not been cooperative. We have a PO Box for Anita, and Fr. B has visited her once, but the daughter doesn’t want anybody else to know where she is. (I.E. The physical location.)

Fr. B discussed the large amount of money in the Altar Guild checking account. Dani moved to close the account, and Ron seconded the motion. The money will be put into the general fund.

Colleen gave a report of the Fall Festival. Although attendance was good – up from last year – the advertising was “dreadful”. The beer garden was not visited as well as it was last year, but the folks manning it did nothing at all to promote it. For the most part, they sat down, and you’d have thought they were visiting the booth rather than trying to encourage people to buy a beer. Fr. B said he will “supervise” next year.

Property Report: The holes in the ground where Ft. Apache was need to be closed off and sealed. They are a danger, and we cannot move the sheds until that is taken care of, and having the pipes under the church filled with stagnant water promotes mold, etc.. The parking lot needs to be sealed before the lines are painted, but it was decided to have the Scouts go ahead and do the painting anyway. The Scout involved needs to complete his Eagle Project by a certain time, and we can’t afford to get the lot sealed for quite a while.

The Annual Meeting will be held after late service on January 20, and the various groups need to have their reports in beforehand, so we don’t have a lot of people standing up and droning on forever.
